EXHIBIT "A"**Initial Articles of Incorporation
Third Section
Purpose Clause**

The purpose for which the corporation is formed is exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code including specifically to promote local gardening, community gardens, and make local food products available to the public; to assist and supplement local food banks, providing food for indigent persons; and to promote and provide educational programs for conservation of natural resources and healthy, nutritious lifestyles.

ALLIANCE FARMERS' MARKET**ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION****ARTICLE VI****LIMITATION**

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to any of its Directors, Trustees, Officers or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Code, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a Corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding § of any future tax code, or (b) by a Corporation, contributions which are deductible under §170(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code.

ARTICLE VII**DISSOLUTION**

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, its assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding Section of any future Federal Tax Code, or shall be distributed to the Federal Government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes. Nothing contained in this Code of Regulations or any other document of this Corporation shall be construed in such fashion as to contravene the provisions of this Article and in case of any question the provisions of this Article shall prevail.
